Meaghan Phair, Farmington River's 3rd Grade Teacher

Meaghan Phair is Farmington River Elementary School's 3rd grade teacher. She is new to the school, replacing Debbie

Dutton, who retired last year. We asked her some questions about herself and about being at Farmington River:

Can you give me a bit of background about you?
