Welcome to all of the new faces in our Farmington River community, as well as to our returning families. We hope you had an enjoyable and restful summer.

Most notably, in October students in K-6 will have the opportunity to enjoy hands-on outdoor nature workshops with *Flying Deer Nature Center* from New Lebanon, NY.
