We have a lot of good news to report this month - so let's get right to it, starting with our Cash Calendar Fundraiser! The daily drawings are underway and are being communicated via email at the end of each week. We are pleased to report that we have reached a new all time high in sales of Cash Calendars - \$13,440, with a **net profit of \$12,515!** Thank you to all of the families, students and staff who so actively participated. Our top sellers were Connor Lewis (\$1,450), Kelly Couch (\$1,290), and Cole Kennedy (\$740). Ms. Beham and Mrs. Decker were the staff members with the highest sales at \$220 and \$190! A special thank you to Sherry DeCelle for leading the charge on this, as well as Dawn Lemon for assisting with securing donations for the calendar, Mrs. Packie for facilitating distribution and collection and to Kwik Print in Great Barrington for producing the calendars cost effectively.

We hosted the Scholastic Book Fair during Read Across America Week for staff and students, and opened to the public on Friday evening. We're happy to report that we earned \$1,576.78 in Scholastic Dollars, which will be spent on NEW library books! Thank you to everyone who purchased books or donated cash.

During this week the PTA also coordinated Dr. Seuss' Birthday celebration, where older students read to younger students. Thank you to Kathy Couch and the teachers for coordinating - it's always a favorite. Kathy also treated the staff to Green Eggs and Ham, "Hop on Pop" corn, One Fish, Two Fish, Red Fish and Blue Fish, Truffula Trees and trinkets.



Our Family Fun Night event on March 4th was a great success – we served pizza to over 80 people, who then were entertained by Bryson Lang, Comedian-Juggler. He had the help of some lovely volunteers and had both the kids and the parents laughing. Thank you to all who joined us!
